

Microphone & Sound



Fixing PC microphone

Requirement

1. You will need a PC microphone to record your voice. You can purchase it from Popular Bookstore or any other computer stores.
2. Your PC has a sound card (built-in or added on).
3. Locate the microphone outlet of your PC. This can be found behind the PC chassis. In newer PCs, additional outlet can be found at the front of PC chassis as well.
4. Connect your microphone jack to the PC "mic" outlet.

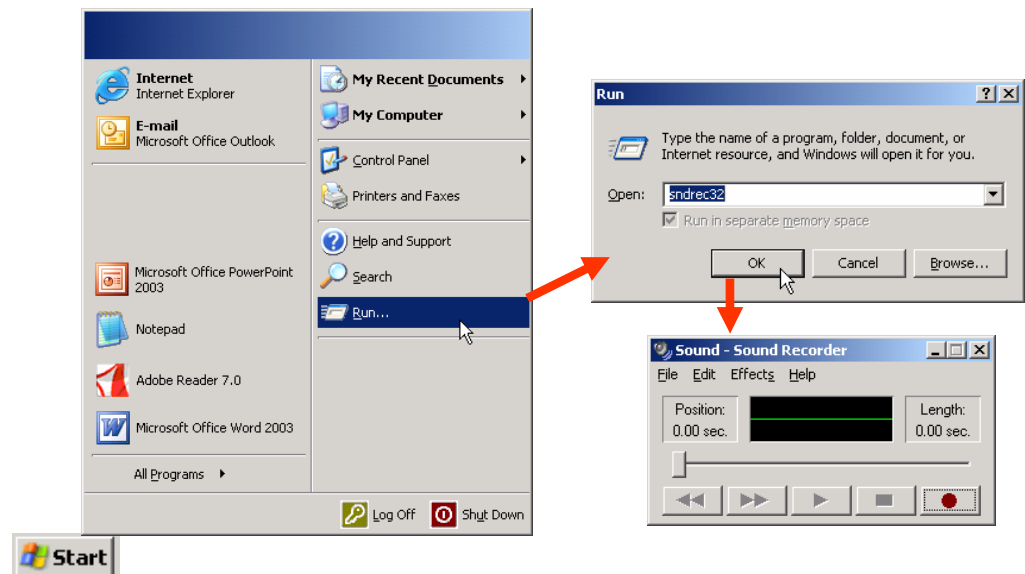

4. Connect your microphone jack to the PC "mic" outlet.



5. To perform a quick test –

- a. Go to Windows "Start" button > Click "Run"
- b. Enter "Sndrec32" on the input box > Click "OK"
In Windows Vista, Enter "SoundRecorder".
- c. Windows Sound Recorder pops-up
- d. Click record button to start recording your voice using the microphone
- e. Click stop and playback button to start listening



Using Built-in Sound Recorder

The built-in DN MultiMedia Sound Recorder is very easy to use. You can record your voice and immediately play back to hear your recitation.

The recording sound file will be saved and since the file is in MP3 format, the file size is small.



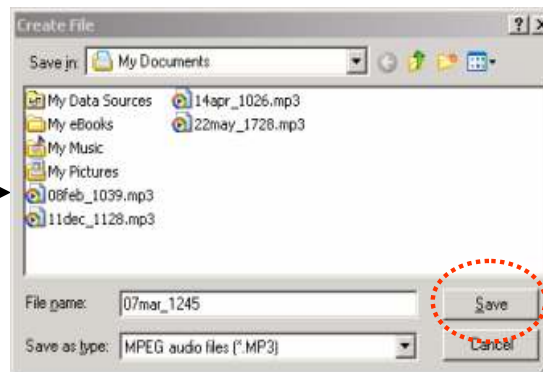
1. Click Sound Recorder icon on Juz Amma main screen > Sound Recorder pops up.



2. Press the recording button.

3. "Creating file" window pops-up

4. Change File name or leave default name. (You can also create new Directory)

5. When you press "Save", recording will start.

6. To stop recording, press "stop" button 

7. Press Playback to immediately hear your recorded voice 



Troubleshooting Recording Problem

Please take note that this has nothing to do with the Juz Amma software.

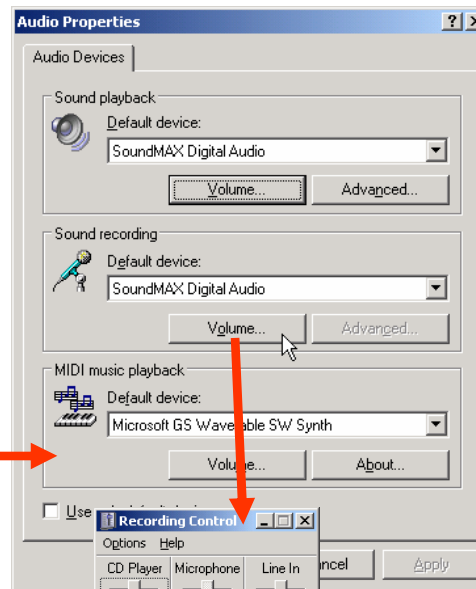
1. Open "sndrec32".
(instruction given in
"Fixing PC microphone")



2. Click "Edit", then go to
"Audio Properties" and
click



3. "Audio Properties"
pops-up



4. Under "Sound Recording",
click "Volume"

5. "Recording Control"
pops-up

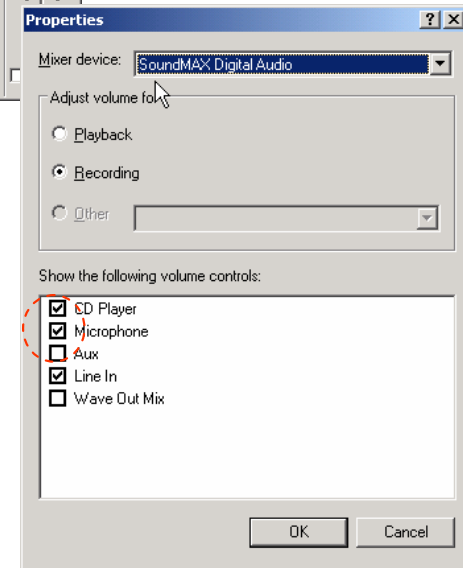
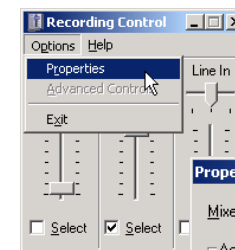
6. Confirm that "Microphone"
box is ticked.

7. Adjust slider up

10. If "Microphone" column
is missing, click Options,
then go to "Properties"

11. "Properties" pops-up

12. Under "volume control",
click box "Microphone".
Click OK.



Adjusting Screen Resolution



Manually adjusting your Screen resolution

The Juz Amma software has been designed to run on the following 2 screen resolutions:

i) 800 x 600 pixels

ii) 1024 x 768 pixels

The program auto detects the end user screen resolution and prompts user to change to one of the above resolution.

In the event where users would like to manually adjust their screen resolution, they can do it by simply following the procedure outlined below:

1. Go to Windows Desktop
2. Right mouse click anywhere on screen
3. A new window pops-up
4. Click "Properties" > "Display Properties" open
5. Click "Settings" tab
6. Adjust "screen resolution" slider to desired resolution
7. Click "OK"
